What is a POLITICAL PRISONER?  A political prisoner is anyone whose imprisonment is politically motivated.  Perhaps the "crime" is politically motivated, perhaps the arrest, trial or sentence has political undertones.	
-	WHAT IS A FAIR TRIAL?  The United Nations sets out international standards on fair trials, by which Amnesty urges countries to abide. Al advocates fair trials within a reasonable time for all political prisoners and works on behalf of such people detained without charge or trial.
 	WHAT IS "CRUEL, INHUMAN, AND DEGRADING TREATMENT?  The term "cruel, inhuman, and degrading treatment" has not been defined by the UN General Assembly, but is intended to be interpreted so as to provide the widest possible protection against abuses, whether physical or mental - such as, prison conditions which do not allow prisoners to sit down or where they are kept blindfolded.
